



## San Diego County Childhood Obesity Initiative Healthcare Domain Minutes July 17, 2015

Attendees: Amanda Schultz, Cheri Hoolihan, Cheryl Moder, Christine Wood, Dean Sidelinger, Natalie Muth, Nina Ghatan, and Stan Miller.

- I. Welcome and introductions led by Stan Miller
- II. Workplan Updates:
  - a. Continued discussion on OB/GYN and pediatrician convening; Yvette LaCoursiere will be invited to a future meeting to discuss challenges and opportunities for OB/GYNS.
    - i. Workgroup also discussed moving the conversation upstream to ensure breastfeeding, 5210, and maternal weight gain are taught as part of the educational curriculum.
  - b. County is working on standardizing EHR, but they are not ready to request data from providers (currently working with CPCMP); looking to track data on screen time, physical activity, and nutrition during physician visits. **Deirdre will present on the BMI registry next month.**
  - c. Request to WIC for data is currently on hold, CPCMG may be able to share data for 22 sites.
  - d. Discussed piloting a program with 211 in a low-income community where doctors (with patient consent) provide patient contact information to 211 staff, who will proactively follow up with patients after appointments to connect them with appropriate resources.
    - i. AKA Head Start is currently partnering with San Diego Hunger Coalition (SDHC) to prescreen for food insecurity. They plan to host a training at the end of August; this could be the future location for the 211 pilot program. **Amanda was invited to attend a future Early Childhood Domain meeting to discuss their efforts.**
    - ii. **Next steps include: drafting a proposal and identifying partners and resources.**
    - iii. Natalie expressed interest in this project and mentioned that CPCMG is launching a clinic in Vista in September, this could be another option for the pilot project.
    - iv. A recommendation was made to give providers posters for the waiting rooms that read, "Ask me about food insecurity or nutrition resources" with 211 contact information at the bottom.
    - v. SDHC is working on seven pilot projects in partnership with UCSD Medical School, **Amanda will be invited to present at a future Leadership Council meeting on findings.**
  - e. Nutrition in Healthcare Leadership Team (NHLT) is working to expand California Thursdays beyond schools to include hospitals and universities. **Nina agreed to connect Colin and Cheri H. to discuss participation in NHLT.**
