



San Diego County Childhood Obesity Initiative Government Domain Minutes July 27, 2016

- I. Welcome and introductions led by Dan Fesperman
- II. Municipal Profiles- Cheryl reviewed updates to the draft healthy city profile for additional feedback.
 - a. Workgroup recommended some minor changes and discussed removing some of the jargon and to make it more user friendly for community members.
 - b. The workgroup will add a new item to the workplan to ensure profiles are updated annually.
- III. Healthy Vending Forum Update- COI, in partnership with the County of San Diego HHSA, UCSD Center for Community Health, and the AHA/ASA hosted a healthy vending forum in June with over 60 individuals in attendance.
 - a. The event made the case for healthy vending and connected institutions with healthy vendors.
 - b. The August newsletter will include a story on the event, so keep an eye out for it.
- IV. Healthy Chula Vista Action Plan Next Steps
 - a. At the April workgroup meeting Stacey presented on the Healthy Chula Vista Action Plan and the workgroup expressed interest in helping to increase awareness of the plan.
 - b. Stacey has already applied to the APA and Childhood Obesity Conferences.
 - c. Additional recommendations included applying to New Partners for Smart Growth, presenting best practices at an upcoming elected officials' breakfast (along with other cities), and highlighting in the COI newsletter.
 - d. County NEOPB is planning to build the capacity of three CBOs to do policy advocacy in the areas of active transportation, healthy food, and the built environment. The RFP will be released in August, and one CBO will be selected per region.
- V. Announcements
 - a. Save the date for the South Bay Hunger Relief Forum on 9/12 from 10am-12pm at the Civic Center Library in Chula Vista.

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- b. COI received a three-year contract with the County and we will begin strategic planning soon, and will create a policy agenda.
- c. The Community Domain will be adding two youth advisory seats (recruited through UCSD Youth Advisory Council) to work collaboratively across the domains.
- d. COI will now have funding for community mini grants to support placemaking.
