- I. Welcome and introductions led by Dan Fesperman
- II. Municipal Profiles
 - a. Presented three different layouts of the municipal profile and the committee finalized the style.
 - b. The committee recommended finding a new government icon and keeping it consistent throughout all profiles. Once the back page is finalized, we'll be ready to launch.
 - c. The workgroup discussed notifying and or meeting with municipalities prior to the official launch.
 - d. As part of the workplan we'll need to identify ways to keep the municipal profiles updated either by interns/ college students or partnering with cities.
 - e. Develop a dissemination plan for the municipal profiles.
 - i. Healthy city grantees will be announced in mid-December.
 - ii. County can also share profiles as a resource for both funded and unfunded projects.
 - iii. COI could host a healthy place forum to provide attendees an opportunity to meet city staff, such as city engineers, and learn about how city budgets work and how to move projects forward.
 - iv. The event could also highlight the use of the policies listed on the profiles.
 - v. Another idea was to "adopt" a city and provide them with technical assistance and resources through the Community Domain, or a RLA to help them keep momentum moving forward.
- III. Workplan
 - a. While reviewing the food and beverage policies, the workgroup discussed revising the benchmark to make it more attainable to better capture changes over time.
 - b. **Dan reach out to JuliAnna regarding healthy vending standards.** We'd also want to see how this would impact the municipal profile results.
 - c. **At our next meeting we can finalize the standards and discuss roll out.**
 - d. **Dan confirm the municipal profiles include the 2015 Walk Scorecard results.**
