<b>COI Mini-Grant Finalization</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• COI will be funding two community improvement projects that support physical activity throughout San Diego County.</li> <li>• The first project will support bike to school efforts at two schools in National City.</li> <li>• The second project will fund an intersection mural in Linda Vista for traffic calming and to support active transportation.</li> <li>• Total funding is \$5,700 and projects will be completed by the middle of next year.</li> <li>• A second round of funding will be available mid-2017.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Develop a mini-grant tracking sheet that captures the organizations that have applied for funding, project, description, and funding amount.</li> </ul>
